# SURFSIDE PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENT DRESS CODE



#### 1. POLICY

School council is responsible for:

Developing and reviewing the dress code in consultation with the Surfside school community to ensure:

- the code reflects the values of the school community
- there is a balance between the rights of individual students and the best interests of the whole school community

Deciding annually if amendments or a full review of the dress code are required

#### 2. PURPOSE

- The purpose of this policy is to ensure all students at Surfside Primary School wear school uniform to school.
- It is compulsory for all students enrolled and attending Surfside Primary School to wear school uniform every day. This includes occasions where students may be representing the school on excursions, sporting events or school functions.

## 3. AIMS

The compulsory wearing of school uniforms at Surfside Primary school:

- Promotes a sense of identity, cohesion and good order in the school
- Allows all students to feel equal
- Prevents bullying and competition on the basis of clothing
- Ensures students' appearance reflects the expectations of their school community
- Enhances the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community
- Strengthens the spirit of community within the school
- Enhances individual student safety and group security
- Ensures all students are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities
- Encourages students to develop pride in their appearance and pride in the school

#### 4. IMPLEMENTATION

#### 3.1 Uniform Choices

- The colours of Surfside Primary School Uniform are navy blue and jade green.
- All children are required to wear full school uniform daily
- Children will be encouraged to wear uniform through positive reward strategies
- Contact will be made with families that are non-compliant with the uniform policy and students may be offered items of school uniform from our wet weather supplies.
- A range of uniform options are available to choose from for comfort and student personal preference.

Jade polo top, long or short sleeve with logo

Summer Gingham dress (checked blue and white)

Note: The school dress is the only checked blue and

white item of the school uniform
Winter jacket fleece lined

Rugby Jumper

Rain jacket with Logo

Navy Blue Rugby jumper with logo Polar fleece vest or jacket with logo

Grade 6 graduation jacket Grade 6 top

Navy blue Track pants- generic no labels

Navy blue Pants or shorts

Navy Blue leggings

Winter skort

Winter tunic

Navy blue shorts or basketball shorts

Navy blue skort

## 3.2 Safety and appearance

Being safe at school is an important consideration when dressing for school.

- Hats: Broad brimmed or bucket hats with logo are compulsory in term 1 and term 4.
- Footwear: Sensible closed toe shoes/runners with socks. (Open toed sandals, thongs, slip on shoes are not acceptable)
- Jewellery: Watches and small earrings are permitted.
- Hair: For the purposes of safety and the management of head lice we appreciate students with hair longer than shoulder length have it neatly tied back with bands in school uniform colours.
- Make up: Make up is not necessary and not permitted.
- Nails: False nails and bright nail polish are unnecessary and discouraged.
- Length of clothing: Any shorts/skirts/dresses need to be at least down to mid-thigh so that all school activities can be undertaken in the appropriate manner.

# 3.4 Human rights and anti-discrimination legislation

Families having difficulty with the costs of uniform are encouraged to contact the Principal. State Schools' Relief can provide assistance with school clothing and footwear through applications made by school principals.

The Uniform Policy will be monitored and reviewed by the staff and School Council annually.
